The March 1st exemption application deadline has passed. In order to file an application for the current year, this statement of extenuating circumstances must be completed and attached to your application and submitted to the Volusia County Property Appraiser's office by September 12, 2024.

The Property Appraiser's decision to grant or deny the application will be reflected on our web site (vcpa.vcgov.org) and on the Notice of Proposed Taxes (TRIM notice) you receive in mid-August.

If you filed an application between March 2nd and August 1st, the TRIM notice you receive **will** likely reflect your exemptions. If not, please contact our office.

If you filed an application between August 2nd and August 18th, the TRIM notice you receive **will not** reflect a change in your exemption. You will receive an amended TRIM notice after August 19th with your exemption status; if your exemption has been denied additional documentation possibly will be required.

If you filed an application between August 19th and September 12th, you will receive an AMENDED TRIM notice. If the exemption you applied for is not reflected on the amended TRIM you may appeal by filing a petition with the Value Adjustment Board.

Petitions are available to file through the Value Adjustment Board web site (volusia.org/vab) or at any of our Property Appraiser's offices.
